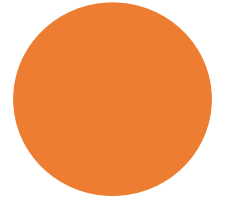

We aim to provide your child with a secure, caring and happy environment in which they will gain skills in all Areas of Learning Experiences (AOLE).

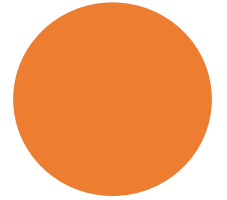
Our teaching is tailored to your child's individual needs. Their needs will already have been identified through a range of baseline assessments.

On a daily basis the children will engage in a range of literacy, Cymraeg, numeracy and DCF activities. Throughout the year we will be covering the six areas of learning.

During afternoon sessions we will be learning through an inquiry-based approach where the adults go on a learning journey with the children.

We will use natural materials and real-life resources where possible and provide a neutral classroom environment suitable for all learners.

School Uniform

We encourage all children to wear school uniform. Consistency in uniform raises the profile of the school in a positive manner. It creates a sense of belonging and unity and presents an image of high standards and expectations. It also promotes the school's ethos and shared positive values.

The school uniform consists of:

- White, Pale Blue or Royal Blue Polo Shirt
- Grey or Black trousers / Knee length shorts / skirt (no jeans or short shorts)
- Royal Blue gingham dress
- Royal Blue sweatshirt, hoody or cardigan.
- Black or Grey shoes or Black or Grey trainers
- A school PE T shirt

Please ensure that your child has weather appropriate clothing as the children access outdoor education daily, so it is important that are dressed according to the weather.

Physical Education

- Our P.E. sessions will take place on our **Wellbeing Wednesday**. During our Wellbeing Wednesday we focus on children's physical, social and emotional development and mental health. Children in Bae 3 will also be having a weekly swimming lesson on Wellbeing Wednesday.
- Autumn Term – Basketball and Dodge Ball.
- Please ensure your child comes to school dressed in appropriate clothing and footwear on this day in order for them to take part. If your child is unable to take part in their P.E. session, please provide your child with a note so that the teacher is aware of this.

They will need to be wearing:


- A T-shirt
- Joggers or leggings
- Trainers
- **All jewellery to be removed and long hair tied up.**

Swimming

Please ensure to pack a swimming kit every Wednesday.

- Pupils require:
 - A suitable swimming costume
 - Goggles
 - Towel
- All jewellery to be removed and long hair tied up.
- If your child is unable to swim, please provide your child with a note so the teacher is aware.

Homework

- The pupils will be allocated a maths and a literacy piece of homework weekly.
 - Homework will be allocated on a Friday and expected to be returned by the following Wednesday.


Can you help us?
